- Apply online at: **www.derby-college.ac.uk**. You'll find an online application form on every programme page. If you need some help, just give the Student Services team a call on **0800 028 0289** or book in at one of our campuses where we'll help you fill in your application.
- We may need to interview you to talk through your options, qualifications, experience and aspirations. For your convenience, interviews will take place throughout the summer. However, in response to the most up-to-date COVID-19 social distancing guidance from the government, interviews may be via methods such as phone/Skype.
- Your interview could include an online screening assessment. This will confirm that the study programme you have selected is at the right level for you.
- Complete your enrolment, secure your place and become part of DCG.

ADVANCED LEARNER LOANS

If you are aged 19 or over, you could qualify for a loan to help pay for your tuition fees as you prepare to head further up the career ladder.

QUALIFY NOW, PAY LATER

An Advanced Learner Loan could help with the costs of your studies at DCG. The loans are easy to apply for, your household income and employment status are not taken into account and there are no credit checks. You will only start repaying in the April after you have completed your programme and when your earnings reach £27,295 per year.

WHAT CAN I USE THE LOAN FOR?

Loans can be used to pay for academic, vocational, technical and professional qualifications at Levels 3, 4, 5 and 6, including Access to Higher Education programmes.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Advanced Learner Loan works in a similar way to the higher education student loans systems. You will apply for it via the Student Loans Company and the payment will then be made directly to DCG. Provided your loan is approved before you enrol, there will be no upfront cost to you.

HOW MUCH ARE THE LOANS FOR?

For all eligible qualifications, the loan will be for up to 100% of the cost of your training, including tuition and material fees. The minimum you can apply for is £300.

HOW TO APPLY

- You will need to have an interview with a member of DCG staff for the subject discipline for which you are applying.
- Information will be sent to you with details of how to apply online.
- You can apply online via Student Finance England.
- If you embark on Access to Higher Education studies and take out an Advanced Learner Loan to pay your fees, the Student Loans Company will write off the amount outstanding once you complete your higher education programme.

SUPPORT AVAILABLE

There is a national bursary fund to help individuals with learning difficulties or disabilities, parents who need help with childcare, and ex-military personnel.

In addition, our Advanced Learner Loan Bursary Fund may help you meet the associated costs of coming to College, such as childcare and travel.

PLEASE NOTE: the details about the Advanced Learner Loan are subject to confirmation and could change.

Advanced Learner Loan

ADULT EDUCATION BUDGET (AEB) FUNDING

Tens of thousands of adults on low wages can see their training fully funded.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR A FREE COURSE?

Previously, unemployed adults had to have been on benefits to receive full funding for their education courses.

But the radical adult education budget has opened the same door for a huge number of other adults who are on low wages of less than **£17,374.50** annual gross salary.

This provides exciting new opportunities for many students, including those on English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) courses who typically take low-paid jobs while they upskill themselves.

PLEASE NOTE: this funding is only available on certain courses. Full-cost courses are still full cost. You may have the chance to use this waiver against courses that are funded, and you will be required to bring in evidence to confirm your eligibility in order to access the waiver.

HIGHER EDUCATION STUDENT FINANCE

Choosing to study a higher education programme is a real investment in your future, leading to better career prospects and greater earning potential. We'll provide all the advice and support you need to overcome any financial concerns you may have.

TUITION FEES

You can pay for your higher education programme through:

- a direct payment to DCG
- sponsorship from an employer
- a student loan

STUDENT LOANS

The Student Loans Company administers financial support for higher education. If you apply for a loan:

- you don't have to pay fees up front
- you don't need to pay back anything until after you have completed your programme and are earning over £27,295 per year
- you won't pay anything back at all if you never reach that salary level

Depending on your household income, you may also be eligible for a maintenance loan to cover your living costs.

APPLYING FOR A LOAN

If you choose to apply for a loan:

- you will need to complete an online form each year you study
- your tuition fee will automatically be paid to DCG

We recommend that you apply for student finance as early as possible. You can do so as soon as finance applications are open and you have accepted an offer.


BURSARIES AVAILABLE

DCG offers a range of bursaries for which students can apply at the start of each academic year. If your application is successful, your bursary will be paid throughout the year.

You will be asked to complete a series of questions via an online questionnaire and provide a short personal statement.

We especially target our support at students:

- from BME backgrounds
- who live in areas where people do not often progress to higher education
- who are the first in their family to undertake higher education
- with an inclusion need



INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

We are an inclusive education provider and work with our students to create an inclusive teaching plan. If you have an inclusion need (such as dyslexia, autism or anxiety for example), please provide us with as much detail as possible. One of the Inclusion Team will be in touch to learn more about you and the methods of support that suit you best. We offer a range of technology support solutions as well as a base room on each campus that you can access.

DISABLED STUDENTS' ALLOWANCE

As a higher education student in England, you can apply for the Disabled Students' Allowance (DSA) if:


- you have a disability (as defined under the Equality Act 2010)
- you have a long-term health condition
- you have a mental health condition or specific learning difficulty such as dyslexia

Disabled Students' Allowances pay for extra support to help you make the most of your studies. This could be for:

- study skills support, such as dedicated support for dyslexia
- specialist equipment such as electronic note-taking software

To ensure that you are well prepared for university as well as employment, we deliver additional support with study skills and academic writing. We have an excellent track record in helping students secure places on honours degrees at university.

The majority of our students secure an Advanced Learner Loan (see page 6) to fund their programme which, under current government guidelines, is written off upon successful completion of a university degree. If you are aged 19-23 and this is your first full Level 3 qualification, then you may also be entitled to full government funding.
